# 2. HDDSTHRESHOLD DISCUSSION AND WAY FORWARD

In Bangladesh, there is no agreed HDDS threshold. Two organisations have set up some thresholds:

Source	Threshold
Dietary Guidelines for Bangladesh, Bangladesh	HDDS less than 5 is considered as poor, 6-8 as
Institute of Research and Rehabilitation in Diabetes,	moderate and >9 as good
Endocrine and Metabolic Disorders	
IFPRI	<b>6+</b> : high = $good\ dietary\ diversity$ ; <b>4.5</b> – <b>6</b> : $medium$
	dietary diversity and <4.5: low dietary diversity

- Damien will contact the global FSC to check whether they have conducted some similar work in other countries

- Tapan will contact ACF (HQ) and IFRI. IFPRI has set up a threshold in Bangladesh and we should understand how they did it. If they have analysed a large dataset to set up the HDDS threshold, we could potentially use it.
