Food Security Cluster Bangladesh Bulletin 2017

FSC messages:

- ✓ The FSC is funded for two years (May 2017 to April 2019) under the Emergency Preparedness Programme (DFID). The funding gap between January and April was covered by FAO, WFP and UNICEF.
- ✓ The Information Management Officer is working part time for the Food Security and the Nutrition Cluster
- ✓ The FSC has 46 Partners in the year 2017
- √ 10 FSC monthly meetings
- ✓ Participation in average:
 - o 18 participants/FSC meeting
 - Representing 13 organisations (donors, UN agencies, Red Cross and Red Crescent family, INGO, local NGO, GoB)
 - o Still not gender balanced with 83% male and 17% female
- ✓ 5 Technical working group meetings (TWG on SOD, various disasters' response, livelihood package, and Sphere review)
- √ 4 Humanitarian Response Plans and 1 Flash Appeal
- ✓ The FSC continue being very active on needs assessment as disasters impact greatly food security. The FSC team supported the NAWG, WFP-VAM and the Nutrition Cluster for 6 needs assessments and surveys conducted in 2017.


FUNDING COORDINATED BY THE FOOD SECURITY CLUSTER

- ✓ The total for the FSC for the 4 HRP and Flash Appeal is 103,487,000 USD
- ✓ It is currently funded at 66,779,160 USD (or 65%) the HRP for the Rohingyas crisis is still on-going
- ✓ **Value for Money**: less than 12 cents are needed to coordinate USD 100 (based on HRP and flash appeal), below the average of the global FSC.

- ✓ Number of medium scale disasters in Bangladesh in 2017 has hampered the quality of the coordination
