General Food Assistance and cooked meals for Rohingya:

GFD distributions have now entered Round 14, as of 17th April. Round 13 of in-kind food assistance run from 3rd and was completed on 16th April, reaching a cumulative 140,773 families (approx. 633,478 people) and included all family sizes (1-3, 4-7, 8+). In April, around 209,027 additional people are receiving food assistance through e-vouchers and 23,000 families fresh food paper vouchers; Cooked meals are being

distributed daily to around 35,000 people through 9 kitchens in different camps.

Livelihoods with host communities, environment and resilience building with refugees:

For host communities and resilience building for refugees in camps and settlements and those living in host communities, a total of 49.841 families were reached:

21.244 families, with Income Generating Activities

7.700 with agriculture inputs, training and resilience building for refugees; 3,216 individuals through incentives for DRR/FFA activities;

360 with socio-economic empowerment initiatives:

17.324 with micro-gardening.

Updates

- ✓ Food Security Sector is coordinating Monsoon/ Cyclone Emergency Contingency Preparedness and Response Planning and tracking of food stocks and disaster risk reduction activities at Distribution Points and wet kitchens for emergency hot meals;
- Energy and Environment Technical Working Group is coordinating a LPG programme with several benefits for refugees and host communities: forestry and environmental protection; energy efficient solutions for cooking capacity (more cooking gas and less firewood); and protection and social cohesion dimensions (safety of young male and female refugees collecting firewood and reduction of tensions between refugees and host communities);
- ✓ Funding gap: only 9% of the total JRP is funded as per **April 2018**
