18 e-voucher outlets are serving more than 214.420 individuals with 19 fresh food items giving refugees more dietary diversity, choice and dignity. GFD (oil, lentils and rice) are currently reaching about 628.185 people. The total population reached is 842,505 individuals. Fresh Food support is implemented by one organizations and four agencies are planning to join in early July. That works as top-up of GFD in coordination with the e-voucher
